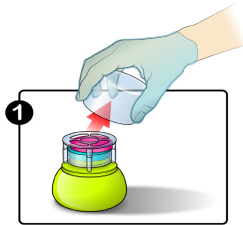


HYGIENE PLAN AND USE

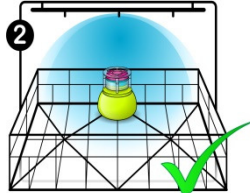
SallóSphere®

It is very important to follow the instructions and recommendations for use.
Place these instructions in the front of the dishwasher.

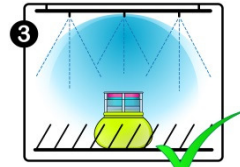
1. Remove the transparent cover
See figure 1



2. Place Sallosphere® as shown in the drawing, on the extreme of the rack, while it is heating the water of the dishwasher. (DO NOT EVERPLACE IT ON THE CENTE See figure 2



3. Do a first wash of activation without tableware, making sure that the washing temperature reaches 50 to 70 °C.

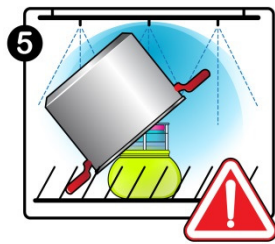


4. Now your dishwasher is ready to start washing as usual...

5. Fill your dishwasher as usual ensuring that nothing covers totally or in part the Sallosphere®

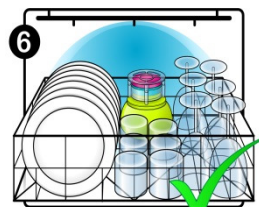


6. It is very important that your Sallosphere® is not covered by any utensil during the entire washing process.
See Figure 5

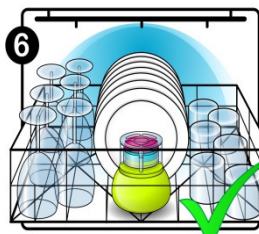


7. It is very important that your Sallosphere® is securely seated in the rack.
See Figures 6

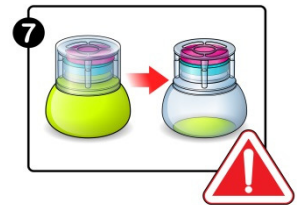
Example of front view

8. Replace your Sallosphere® when it runs out of product. Cover the Sallosphere® dispose of in recycling. See Figs 7 and 8



Very important note!

To achieve a satisfactory result and make the most of Sallosphere®, ensure the use of one Sallosphere® in every rack.

In high use establishments, it is enough to use one Sallosphere® every two racks to achieve a premium result.

- Make sure that nothing covers totally or in part the Sallosphere®
- Make sure your sprinklers are working properly: rotation, pressure, etc.
- Make sure your Sallosphere® is correctly positioned: Face up and on one side of the rack, never in the center
- Make sure your dishwasher reaches 50 °C to 70 °C in the washing process and 70 °C to 80 °C in the rinse

Warnings

- Do not handle Sallosphere®
- Do not shake it and do not put it faced down, the liquid that releases is corrosive.
- Do not remove the dosing cover, nor the sponges, nor the fibers.
